### Prep & Cooking Suggestions

Mahon is a hearty and stable cheese, designed to keep well. Uncut wheels may be stored in refrigeration for several months. Once cut, wrap unused cheese tightly in plastic. If mold grows on the cheese, it may be scraped off or dabbed with a vinegar solution.
